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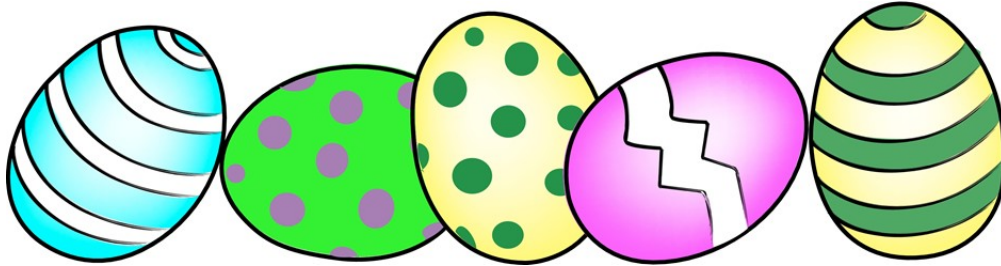

Your school is invited to take part in the ELSA study

The ELSA study is screening children aged 3-13 years to find those at risk of insulin dependent diabetes. We can then offer education and monitoring to at risk children and their families. This is to stop children from getting too unwell, offer treatment sooner and offer further research which aims to delay or prevent diabetes.

The screening test is a single finger-stick blood test [1] that can be done at home, at school or in the community and is sent back to us for testing. ELSA aims to screen 20,000 children across the UK until February 2025. Testing in schools means we can offer this research to even more children and young people.



What will happen if my school decides to take part?

We will arrange a date for an ELSA clinic to be held in school, a team of nurses will come and take the fingerstick test from the children. Schools will need to send or email study information to pupils and parents/guardians. Those interested will be able to register and consent to take part in the study online or by post. Parents can choose for a home-testing kit instead of in-school testing.

If schools prefer not to have in-school fingerstick tests they can just send the study information out to parents for home testing.
