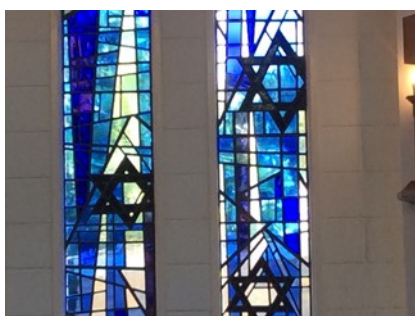
Wishing you a safe and restful summer break. I look forward to welcoming you back on Wednesday 6 September 2023 when we join the St Benet's family.
