

Maths

In our Math's lessons this term, we will be working on:

- Place value (within 20)
- Addition and subtraction (within 20)
- Place value (within 50)
- Length and height
- Mass and volume

To support with our maths learning, we will be using an online programme called Sumdog. When children are confident in logging in, in class, these login details will be sent home.

Music

We will be following the Charanga units 'In the Groove' and 'Round and Round.'

'In the Groove' is a song to learn and has been arranged in six different styles: Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk.

'Round and Round' presents an integrated approach to music where games, the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc), singing and playing instruments are all linked.

PSHE

We use the Jigsaw programme to teach PSHE. This term we are looking at the unit 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy Me.'

'Dreams and Goals' we will be learning about aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this.

'Healthy Me' we will be learning about being and keeping safe and healthy.
