

## Maths

In our Math's lessons this term, we will be learning about:

- Multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Geometry (Position and direction)
- Place value (within 100)
- Measurement (Money)
- Time
- Consolidation of our years learning

We continue to use Sumdog, an online tool to support our learning.

## Music

We will be following the Charanga units 'Your Imagination' and 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay.'

'Your Imagination' is a song about using your imagination.

'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' consolidates the learning that has occurred during the year. All the learning is focused around revisiting songs and musical activities, a context for the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.

## PSHE

We use the Jigsaw programme to teach PSHE. This term we are looking at the units 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'.

'Relationships' we will be learning about building positive, healthy relationships.

'Changing Me' will be learning about coping positively with change.
